For Intended Parents (IPs):

Intended Parent Requirements & Criteria:

- SI, Inc. does NOT discriminate against potential recipient parents of any race, creed, gender, or otherwise. We proudly represent single individuals as well as couples in heterosexual and homosexual marriages or committed partnerships.
- We represent IPs both domestic and abroad.
- May be required to submit to a background test – We do NOT represent IPs with criminal histories that could pose any sort of threat to children. NO reports, complaints, or convictions of abusing or harming children in any way.
- Emotional and Financial stability needed to commit to the Surrogacy/IVF process and ultimately to raising a human being.
- Ability and willingness to travel to the United States or any necessary reason as it is related to the Surrogacy and the child.
- Other requirements may apply.

Gestation v. Traditional Surrogacy:

In a gestational surrogacy, an embryo is formed outside of the womb and transferred to the surrogate's uterus to carry. This process utilizes in vitro fertilization technology and is more medically involved. The resulting child, however, has no genetic relation to the surrogate and can actually have a full or partial genetic match to the intended parent(s). In a traditional surrogacy, the surrogate is impregnated naturally or artificially using her own egg(s). While this process more closely resembles natural conception, it becomes very complex emotionally and legally since the resulting child is genetically related to the surrogate. While uncommon, there are still places that allow traditional surrogacy arrangements. It is highly discouraged and often legally unsound. Surrogacy International, Inc. only does gestational surrogacy arrangements so we can best protect the rights of all parties involved legally and emotionally.
